

The World's Largest Tarot Reading

World Tarot Day (May 25th)

Over 100 readers worldwide took part in the World's largest Tarot reading on one day, World Tarot Day (May 25th). The cards chosen were summarised in order of receipt, and in some cases translated to a Waite-Smith equivalent, our "common language" for this particular reading.

We can now reveal the results, and the "hidden secret" of this event, which was to produce a long sequence – in order – of cards for you to use the "Opening of the Key" method of card counting! You can also take this reading as a 1-card, 3-card, or 10-card Celtic Cross reading, all to answer the same question we posed as worldwide Tarosophists:

"What is the Spirit of Tarot telling us for the year ahead?"

The 104 cards were as listed below, but in summary, the most picked card was the STAR.

The next cards chosen most (drawn randomly from decks) comprise the 3-card reading:

STAR + 4 of Pentacles + Justice

To use the most commonly-picked cards as a Celtic Cross, these are the cards:

Significator: The Star

Position 1: 4 of Pentacles

Position 2: Justice

Position 3: 2 of Pentacles

Position 4: 6 of Pentacles

Position 5: 6 of Swords

Position 6: 7 of Wands

Position 7: 8 of Pentacles

Position 8: Ace of Cups

Position 9: Knight of Cups

Position 10: Page of Pentacles

Base Card: The World

For those looking at the numbers, we had:

9 Fours, 8 Aces, 7 Sixes, 6 Twos, 6 Eights, 5 Sevens, 4 Threes, 3 Tens, 3 Nines, 3 Fives

And a majority of Majors and Pentacles!

For those who might wish to attempt to card-count the sequence, using the Golden Dawn correspondences, the “Opening of the Key”, dignities and pairing – here’s the full sequence:
